Mr. Skokanic updated the Board regarding the HOA CDD cost sharing, noting 39 that the CDD paid for the 11th Avenue planting and the HOA paid for the 40 planting around the Amenity Center. He stated that the growth around the 41 42 lake banks has been addressed as has the cut-back on the Nature Trail.

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### B. Aquatics Update

## i. Presentation of Waterway Inspection Report

Mr. Simoes presented the aquatics report and adding additional plants on pond five to block view of the nature trail from residents. He estimated that it would take approximately 10 Carolina Willows to complete the project.

#### C. District Counsel

No Report presented.

#### D. District Engineer

Mr. Brletic updated the Board on the status of the pond 6 conversion project, noting that he is expecting to have the permit by the end of the week. However, he does need an update from Solitude on the revised start date and has requested pictures of the work performed on the control box, general elevations, and milestones. District Management was asked to follow-up with Solitude on these things.

### E. District Manager

Mr. Huber provided an update regarding Phase 3 re-opening of District Amenities, noting that Executive Order 20-246 expires on October 31<sup>st</sup>, so the December and subsequent meetings will be held in-person. The December 14, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. Possible meeting locations were discussed with the decision made to meet at the Firehouse Cultural Center, located at 101 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue NE, Ruskin, FL 33570. It was noted that there is a fee of \$150/meeting for this location.

Mr. Huber informed the Board that through August the District has spent \$236,185 and is under budget by approximately \$17,000.

Mr. Huber led discussion regarding the RFP for tree pruning and setting a not to exceed amount to facilitate with completion of the project in a timely manner, as well, as ongoing maintenance.

On a Motion by Mr. Orlando, seconded by Mr. Dealaman, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors set a not-to-exceed amount of \$7,000 for the tree pruning project and authorized staff to negotiate an addendum to the Duvall contract for ongoing tree maintenance for the Bahia Lakes Community Development District.

Consideration of Resolution 2021-01, Declaring Vacancies

Mr. Huber presented Resolution 2021-01, explaining that seats 1 and 2 currently held by Mr. Skokanic and Mr. Fiorelli respectfully were to be filled via the general election, but no one qualified to run for those seats. Therefore, the District will need to appoint two Supervisors to fill them after November 17, 2020, which is when the new Supervisors would have been seated were the seats filled as part of the election process.
